



## NATIONAL DIPLOMATIC VISA

### GENERAL OVERVIEW

The national diplomatic visa, for accreditation or notification, is intended to allow a long-term, indefinite stay for foreigners holding diplomatic, service, and, exceptionally, ordinary passports (in the latter case, subject to specific authorization from the Diplomatic Protocol Office), who are intended to serve at their country's diplomatic-consular representations in Italy or at the Holy See, as well as other accredited international organizations.

The procedure for issuing a visa consists of the following steps:

1. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan or the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Tajikistan will request the Italian Embassy in Tashkent (via a Note Verbale to be delivered in person or sent by email to [segreteria.tashkent@esteri.it](mailto:segreteria.tashkent@esteri.it)) to issue a diplomatic visa to the applicant and their family members. It is essential that the applicant's telephone number and email address are included in the Note Verbale.
2. following receipt of the aforementioned Note Verbale, the Italian Embassy in Tashkent will request authorization to issue the diplomatic visa from the Protocol Office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation in Italy;
3. After receiving clearance from the Protocol Office, the Italian Embassy in Tashkent will contact the applicant to schedule an appointment for themselves and each of their family members to submit the diplomatic visa application and the following documentation to be attached to the application.

### CHECKLIST OF SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

1	<p><b>National Visa application form duly completed and signed in original by the applicant.</b></p> <p><i>For minors under 18, the form must be signed in original by both parents at the Embassy when submitting the application to the designated Official. Both parents and the minor must be physically present at the Embassy.</i></p>
2	<p><b>A recent (no older than six months) passport-sized photo with a white background <a href="#">ICAO</a></b></p>
3	<p><b>Original passport.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>the passport issue date must not be older than 10 years;</i></li> <li>• <i>the passport must be valid for at least 90 days from the expiry date of the requested visa;</i></li> <li>• <i>The passport must contain at least two blank pages.</i></li> </ul>
4	<p><b>Photocopy of passport.</b></p>
5	<p><b>Photocopy of Uzbek or Tajik identity card.</b></p>
6	<p><b>Booking flights.</b></p> <p><i>If the applicant is a minor, his or her name must be indicated on hotel and flight reservations, along with the full names of the accompanying parents.</i></p>
